## **Kentish Lions Christmas Parade 18/12/2009**

Parade starts 6.00 pm sharp at **TANDARA**.

Set up at 5.00pm for registration and numbering.

**SAFETY IS EVERYTHING-** for yourself and the audience. Is everything secure? Can you stop in time? Children may leap out of the crowd unexpectedly. Double check everything.

Lions Parade Marshalls can ask you to withdraw if they regard your entry as unsafe or not in the spirit of the parade—it is a family Christmas event – not an advertisement.

The Lions Club organise and hold Public Liability insurance for the Parade. By being in the Parade you agree to follow their directions.

No loud or sudden noises, especially near livestock which may get spooked.

**No water bombing**, flour bombing, or spraying anything from your float or entry.

**No lolly throwing**. If you wish, you may walk alongside your entry and hand out lollies.

Children and animals on your entry must be closely supervised and restrained.

No Santa's. There is only one Santa Claus & the Lions Club has the real one!!

Once the parade is underway, you must not get on or off moving vehicles.

Go slowly!! It is not a race to catch the float in front of you. Keep at least two car lengths from the float in front of you. Walking pace only.

Please line up in King George V Park after the end of the parade. That is when prizes will be awarded, and when other activities will be happening. Finishes at 8.00 pm.

If you wish to have a stall in the park after the parade, just ask. It's free. We don't want to duplicate things though, so call Don Thwaites 64911682.
